THINK AHEAD AND MAKE SURE YOU CAN VOTE IN THE EU Elections, 23 MAY 2019



GET REGISTERED TO VOTE BEFORE 7 MAY

Remember if you have moved since you last voted or will change address by **23 May** you should register again. You don't need to register again if you have already registered.



TO REGISTER QUICKLY HAVE YOUR NI NUMBER READY

Don't have your National Insurance number? Call **0300 200 3500** or visit gov.uk/nationalinsurance ASAP so it's sent to you before **7 May**.



UNSURE IF YOU'LL BE AT YOUR HOME OR TERM-TIME ADDRESS?

You can register at both, but can only vote once in the elections. Register at gov.uk/register-to-vote. Remember, it is an offence to vote twice.



ON HOLIDAY, UNSURE WHERE YOU WILL BE OR CAN'T GET TO YOUR POLLING STATION ON 23 MAY?

Once registered, apply for a postal vote by **5pm** on **7 May**. Or apply for a proxy vote by **5pm** on **15 May**.
