

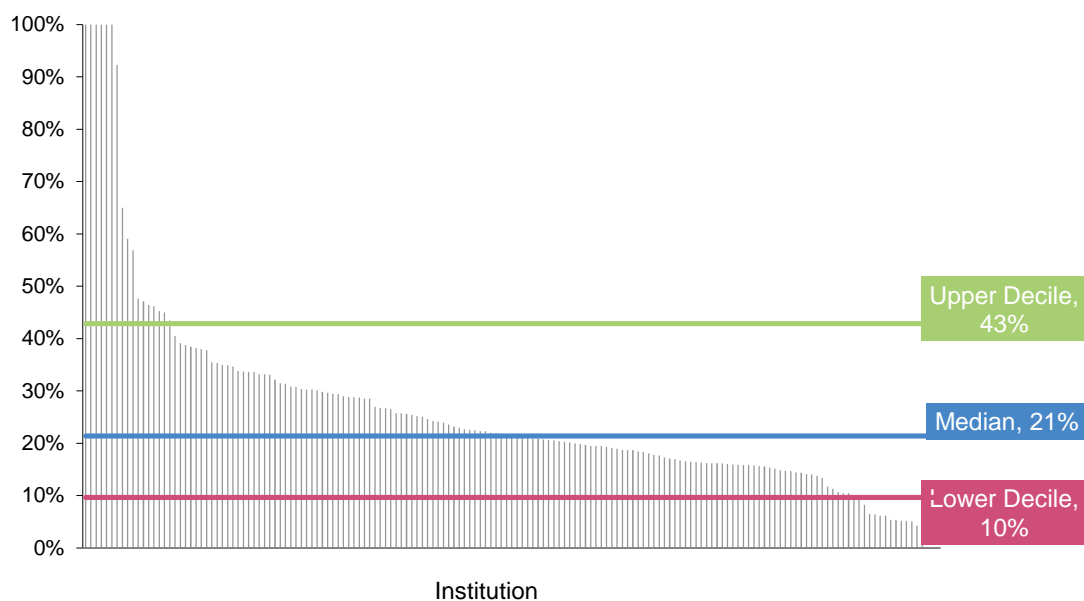

Section B: Patterns of institutional diversity

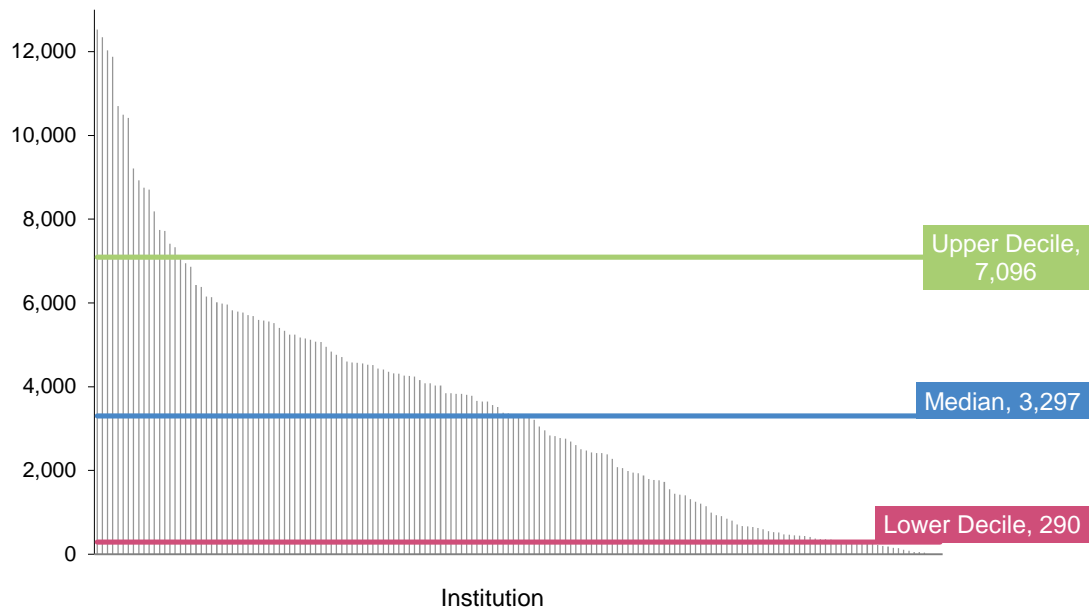
This section illustrates, in the form of institutional charts, some of the key student, staff and finance distributions across higher education institutions in the UK. Unless otherwise stated, the finance and staff charts cover the 163 institutions in receipt of funding from the funding councils, together with the University of Buckingham. The institutional charts are based on student data, and finance ratios featuring student data exclude figures for the University of Wales (central functions), which has staff but no students.

The data is from the HESA student, staff and finance returns for 2011–12, and the Performance Indicators for 2011–12. Charts 3, 24, 29, 30 and 34 each have one outlier not represented on the chart; charts 36 and 37 each have two outliers not represented on the chart. These values have been excluded to make the distribution as a whole more visible in chart form.

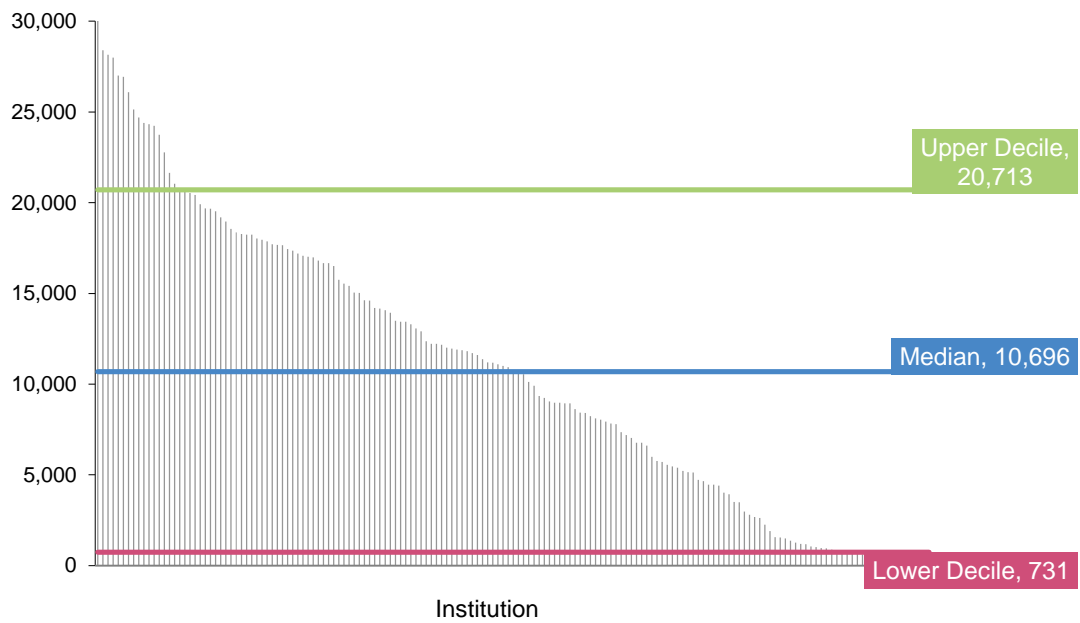
1. Percentage of postgraduate students



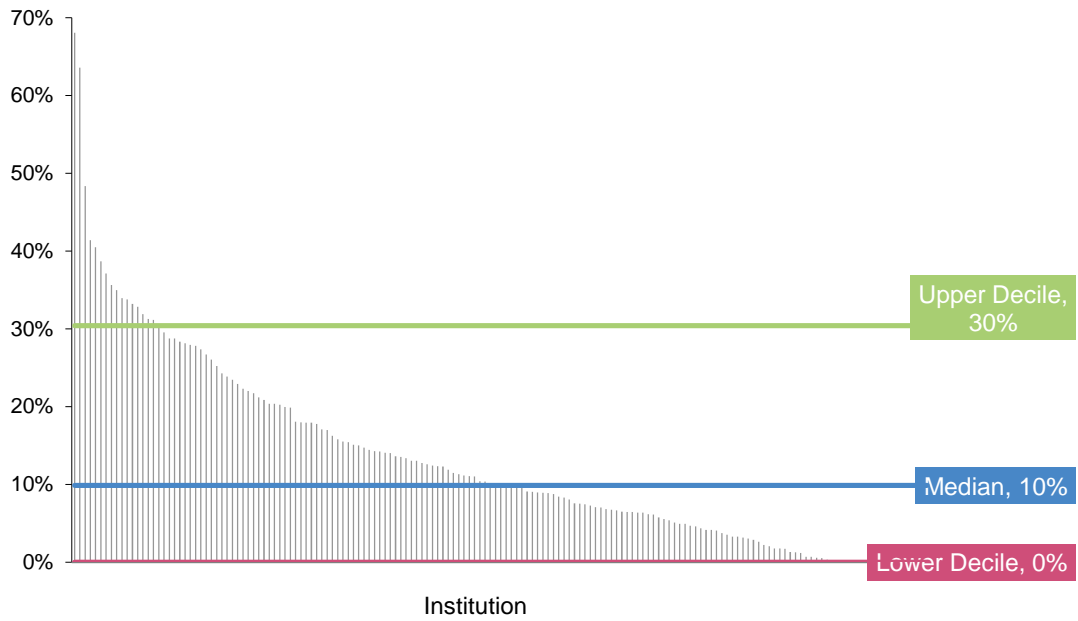
2. Number of postgraduate students



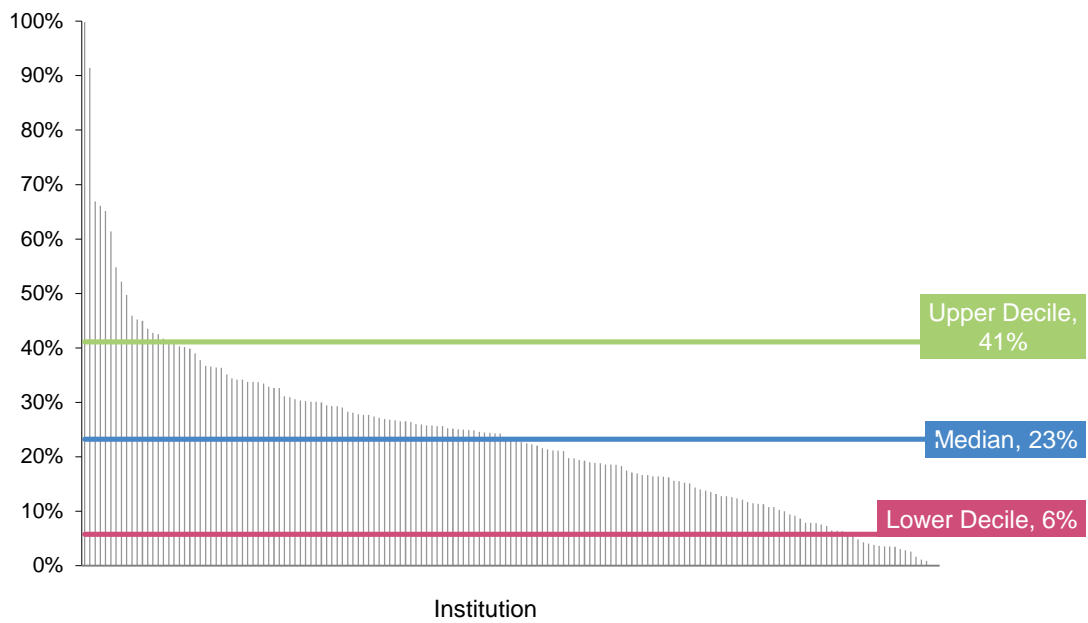
3. Number of undergraduate students



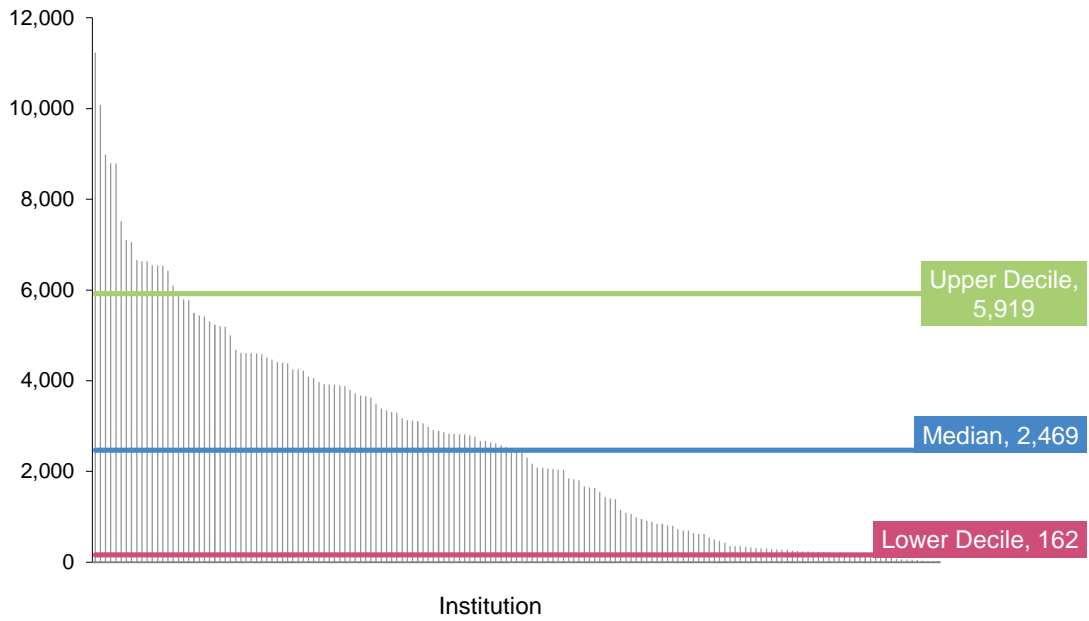
4. Percentage of other undergraduate students



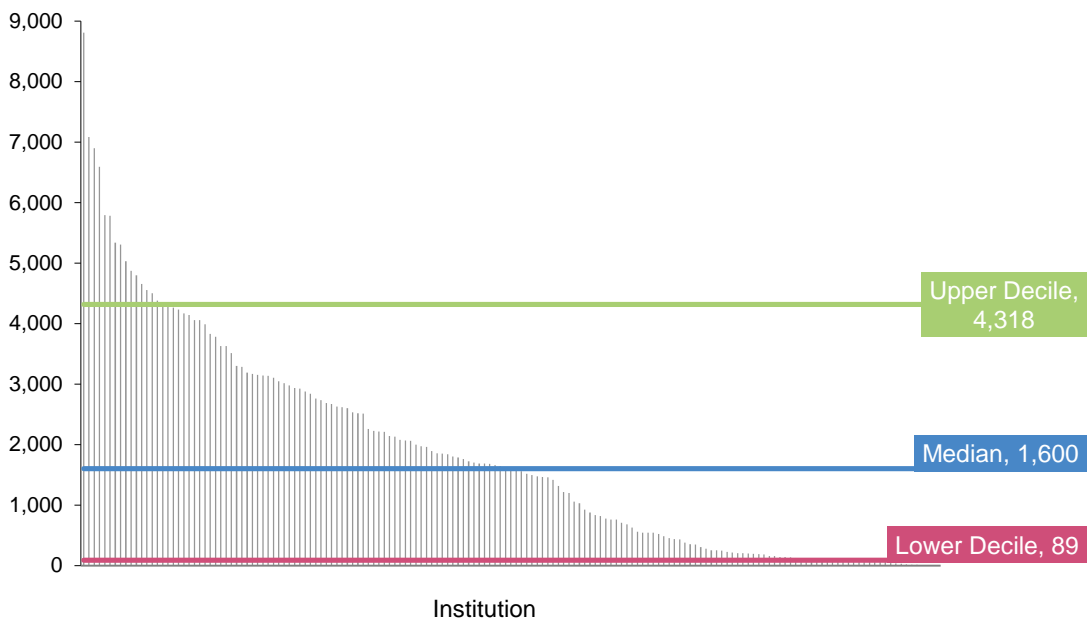
5. Percentage of part-time students



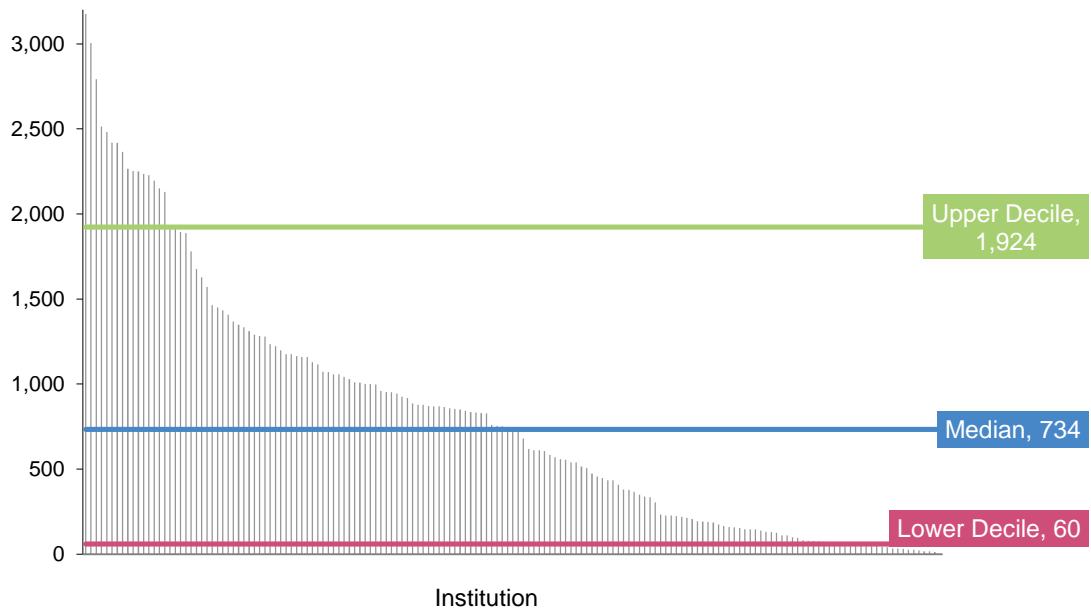
6. Number of non-UK domiciled students



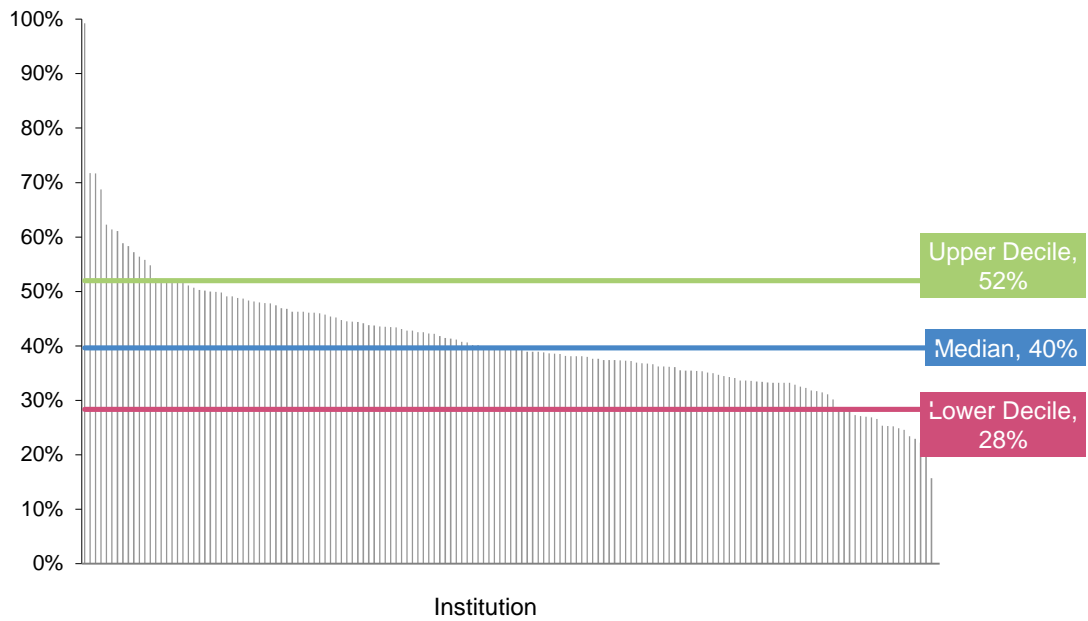

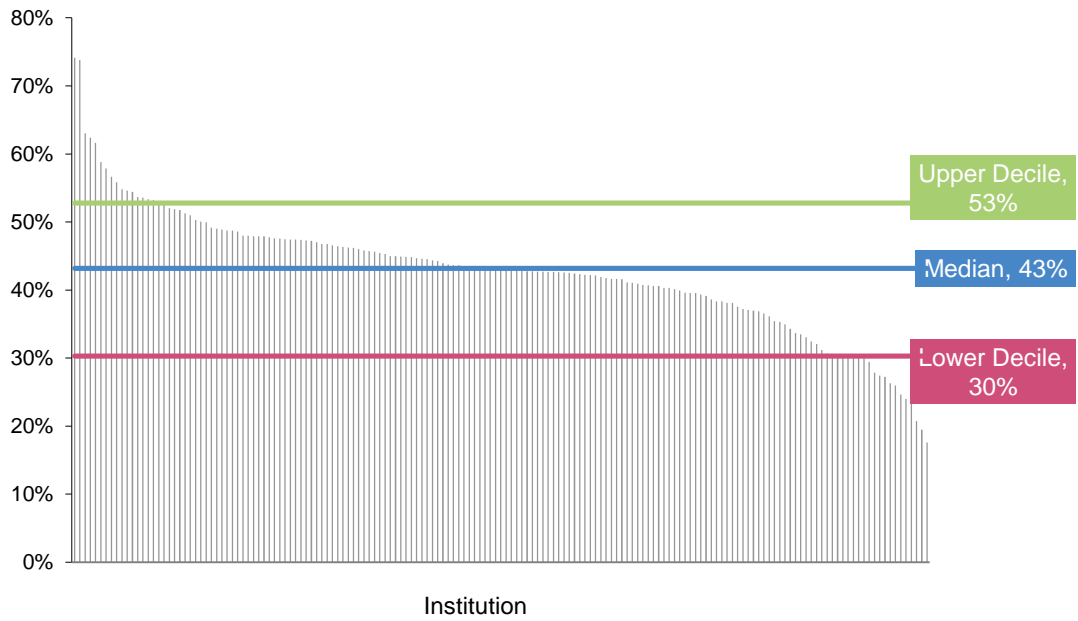
8. Number of EU (excluding UK) domiciled students



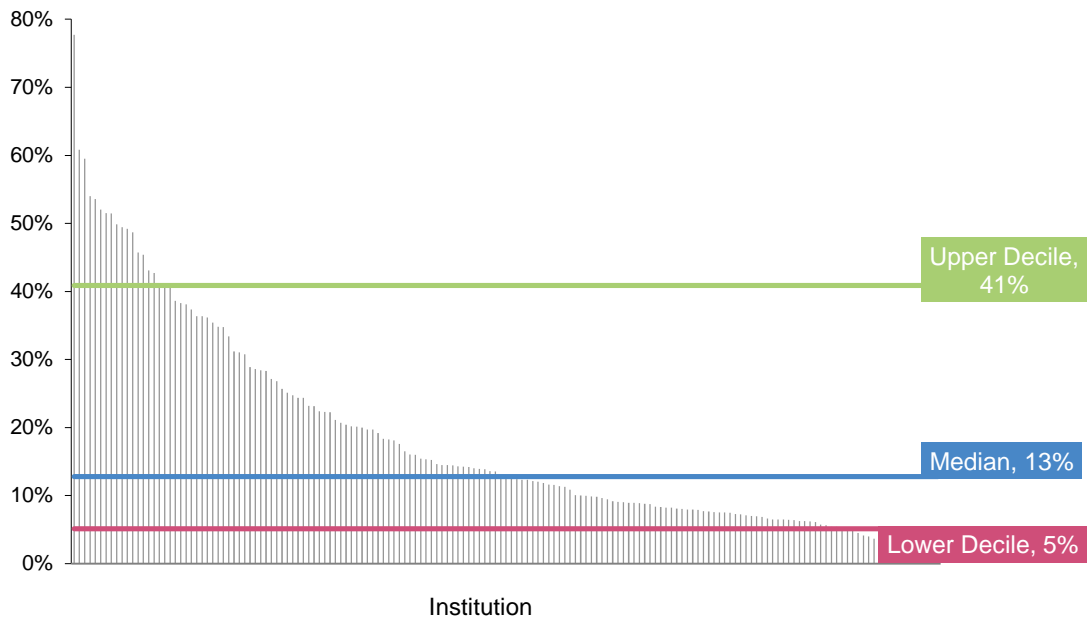
9. Percentage of mature full-time undergraduate students



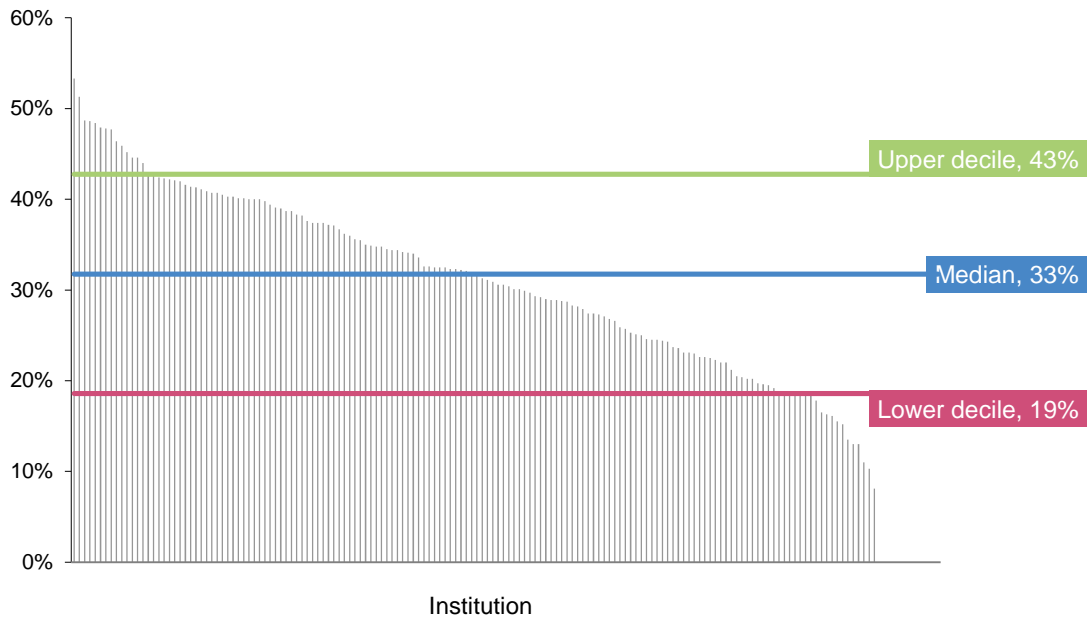

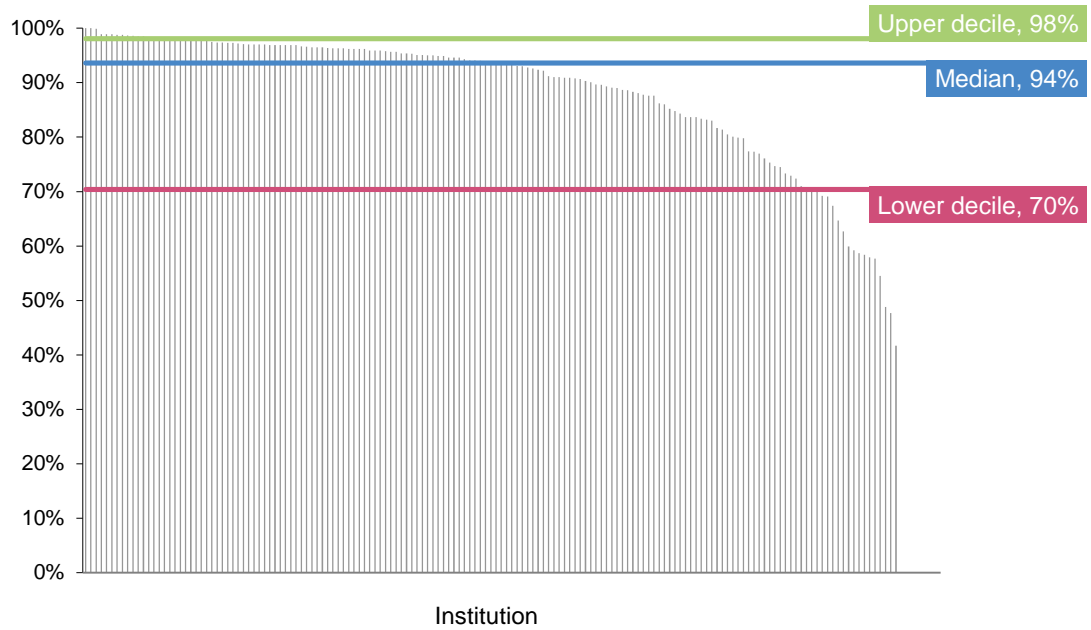

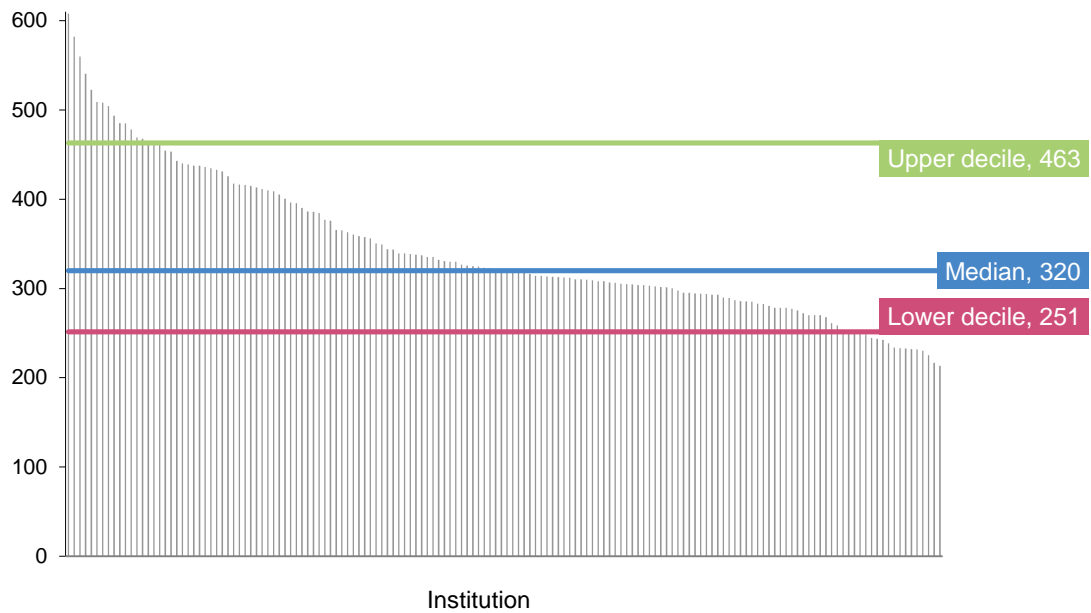
12. Percentage of young full-time first degree entrants from NS-SEC classes 4, 5, 6 and 7



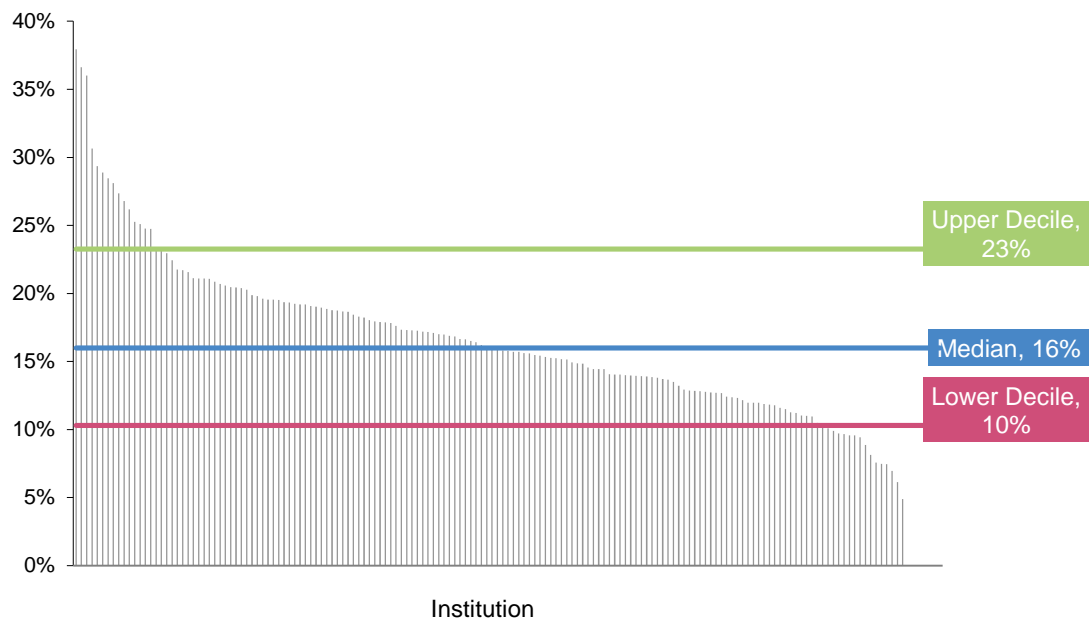
13. Percentage of young, full-time, first degree students from state schools



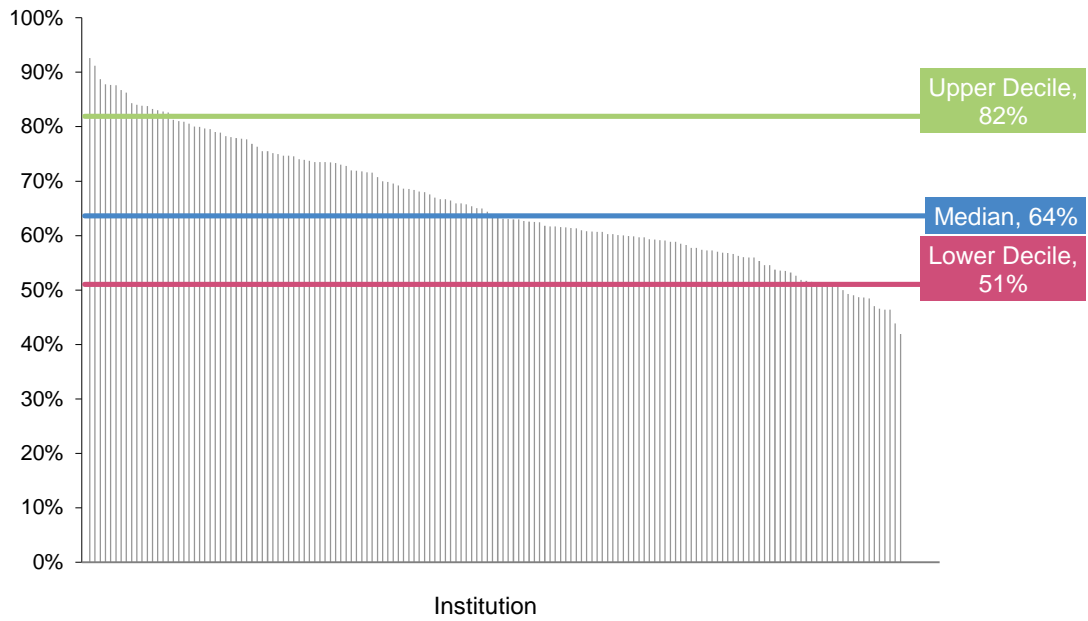
14. Average tariff points of entrants to full-time undergraduate courses



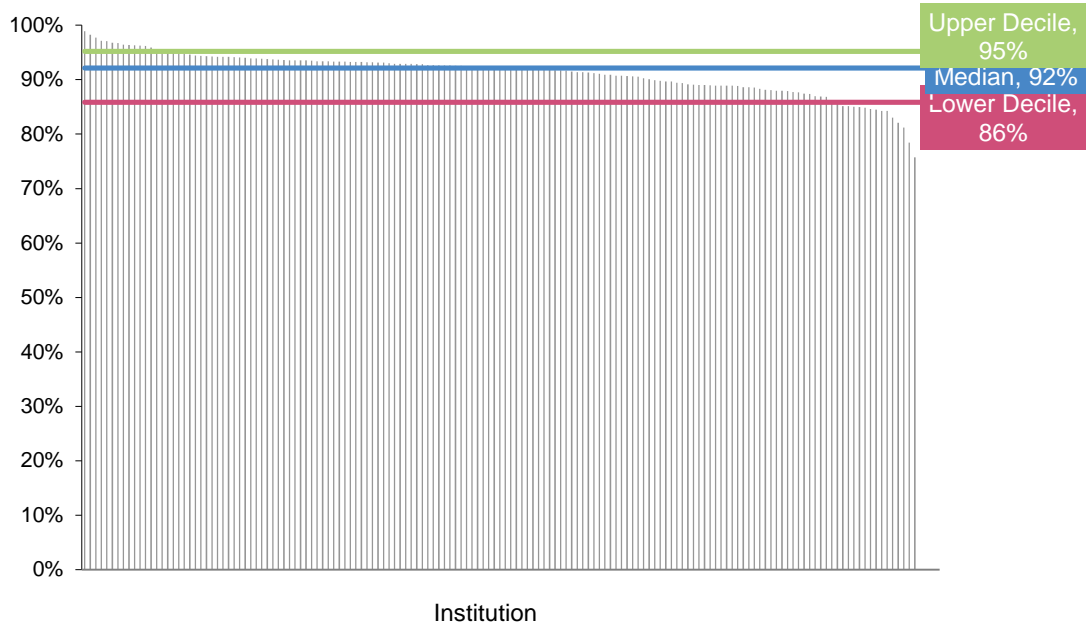
15. Percentage of first-class degrees awarded



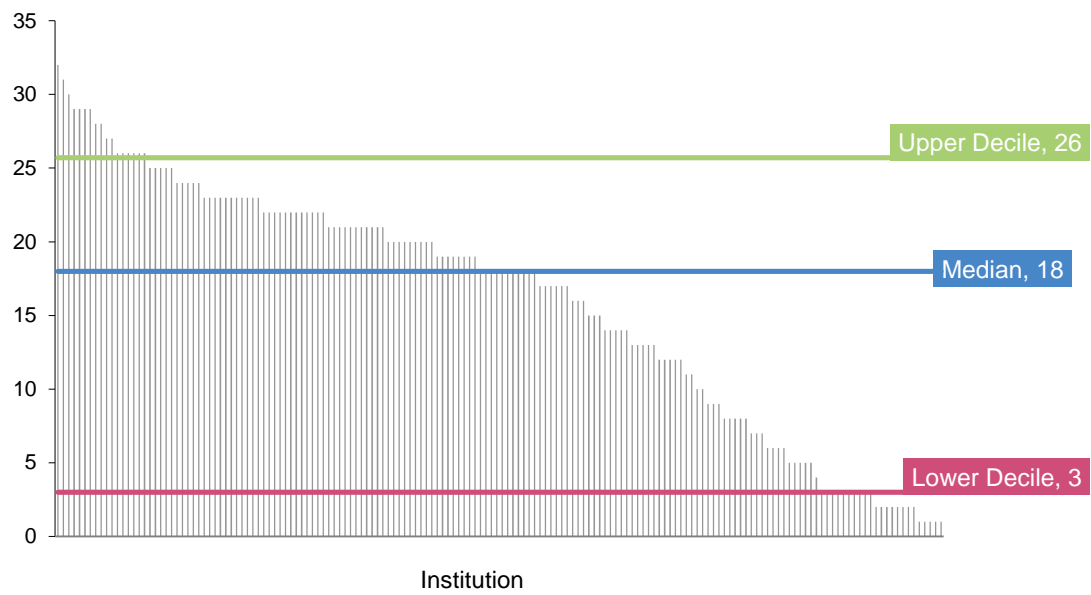
16. Percentage of first and upper second class degrees awarded



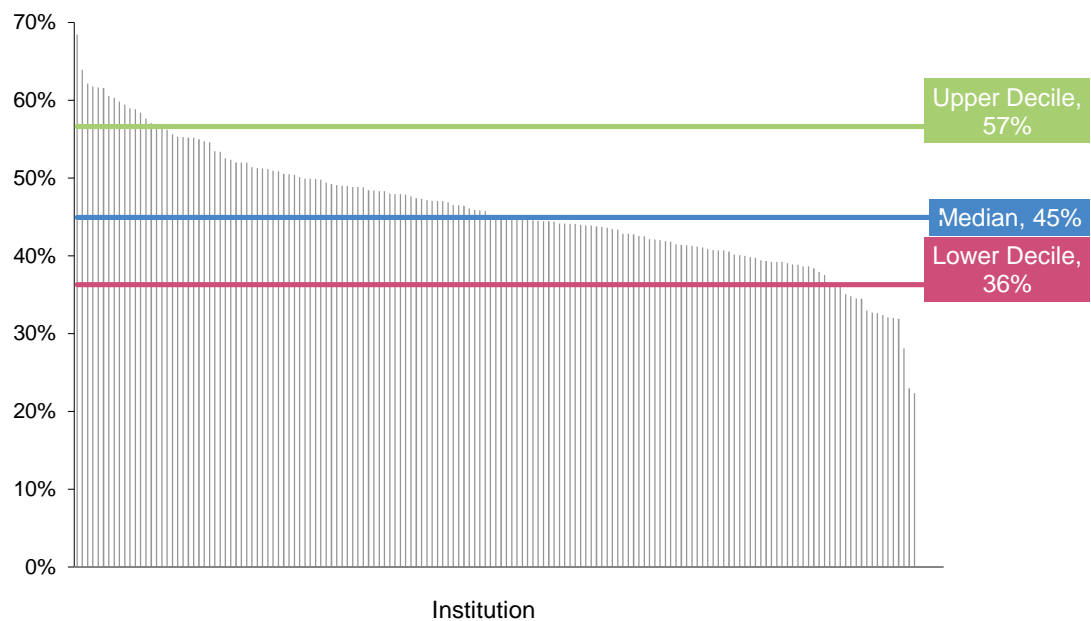
17. Percentage of UK-domiciled first degree full-time graduates not unemployed



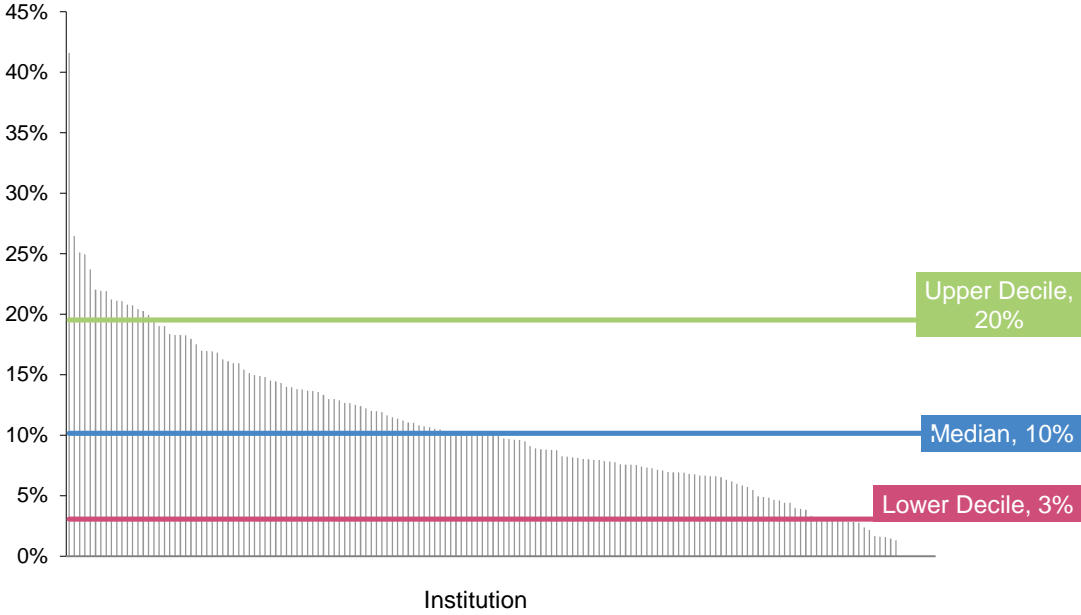
18. Number of cost centres within which academic staff are employed



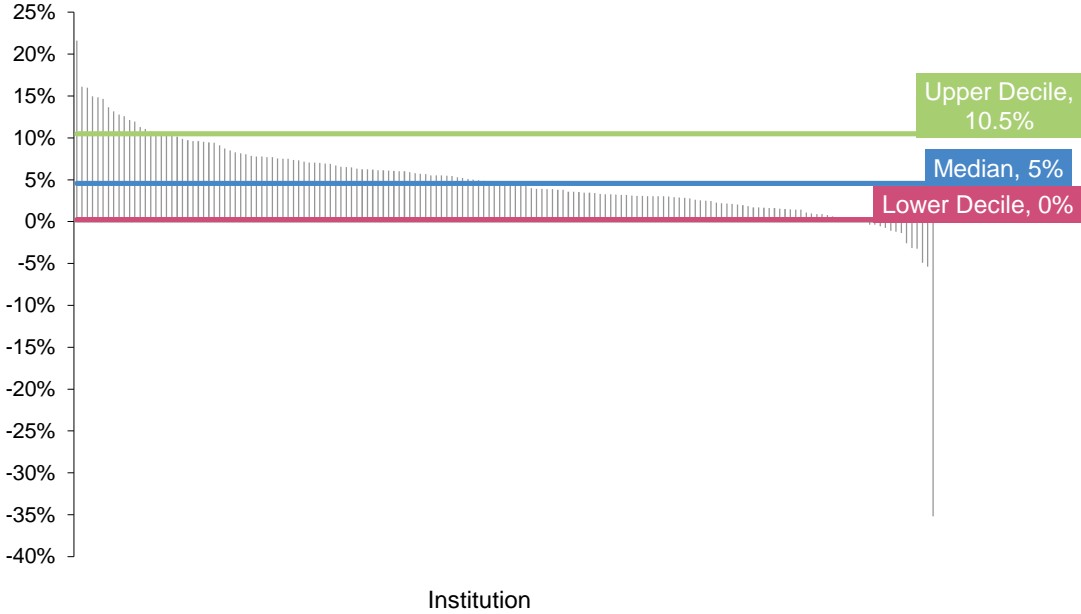

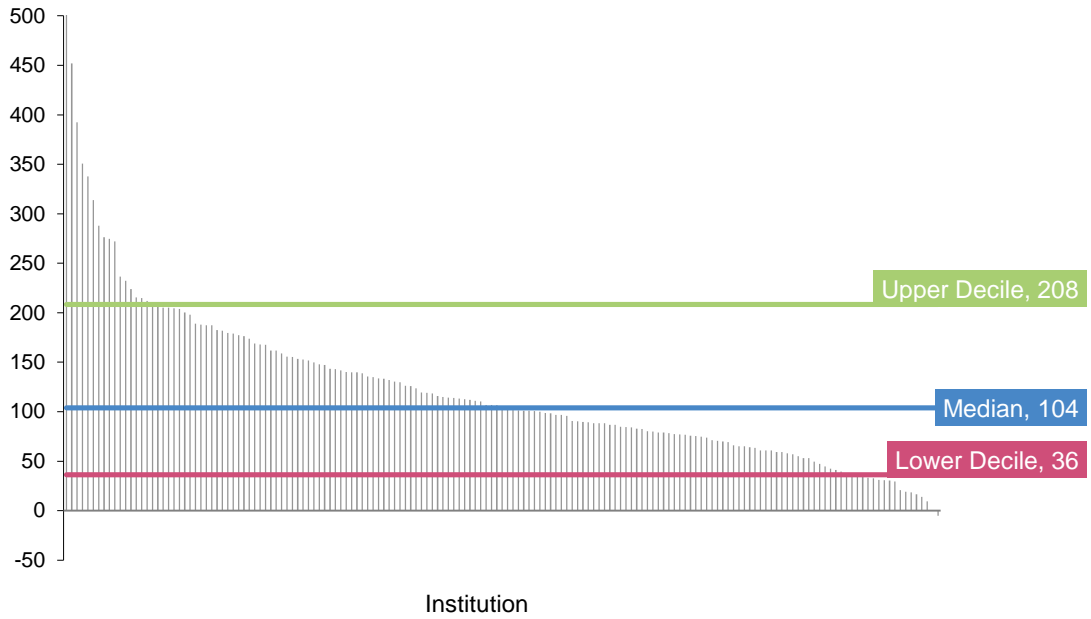

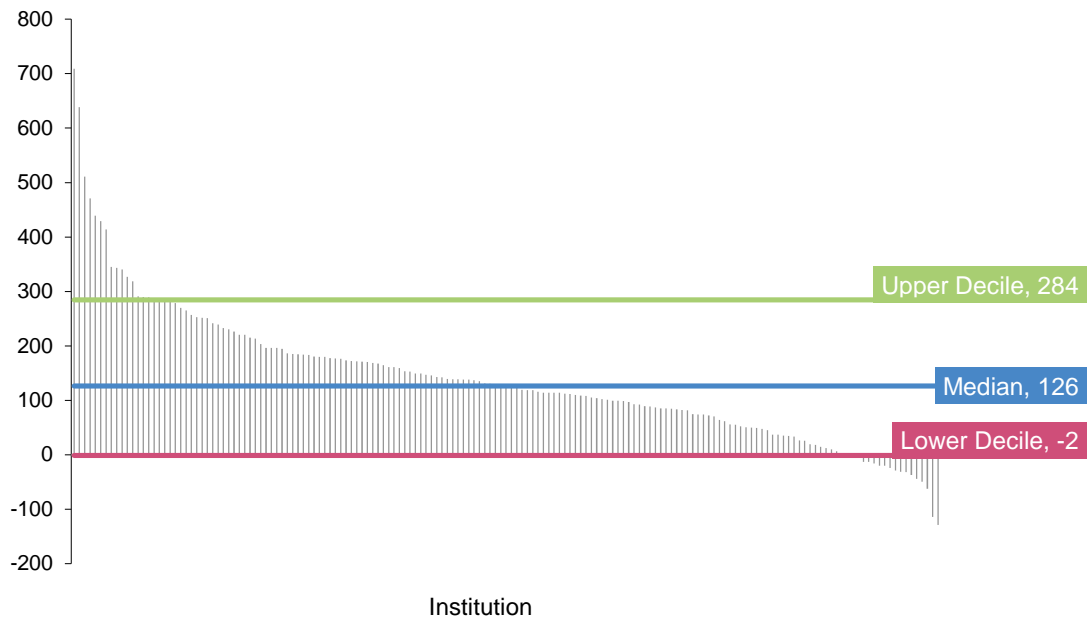

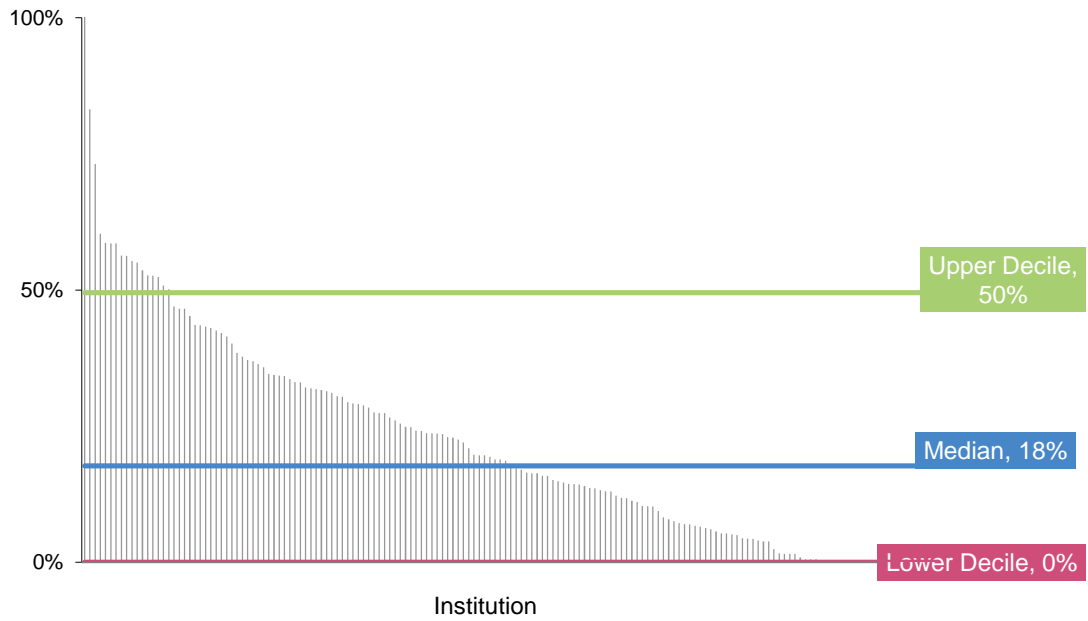

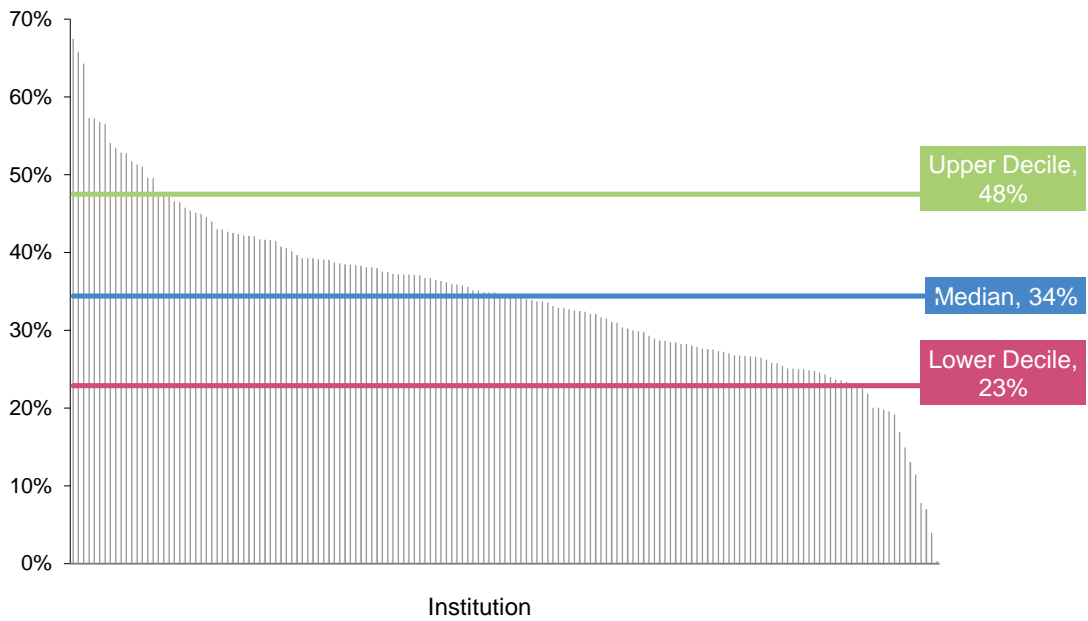

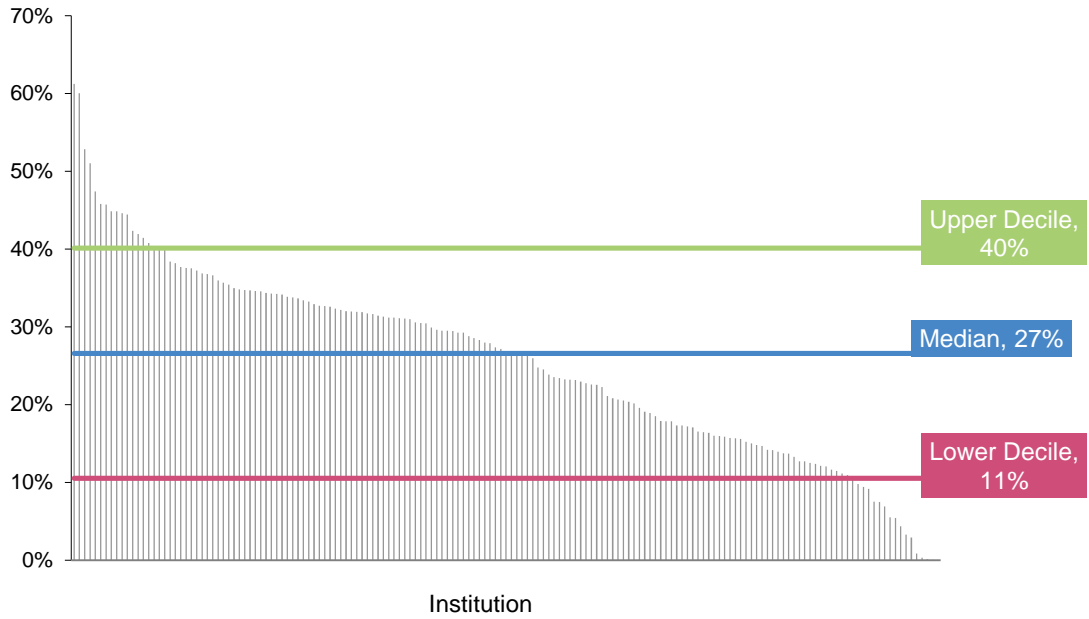

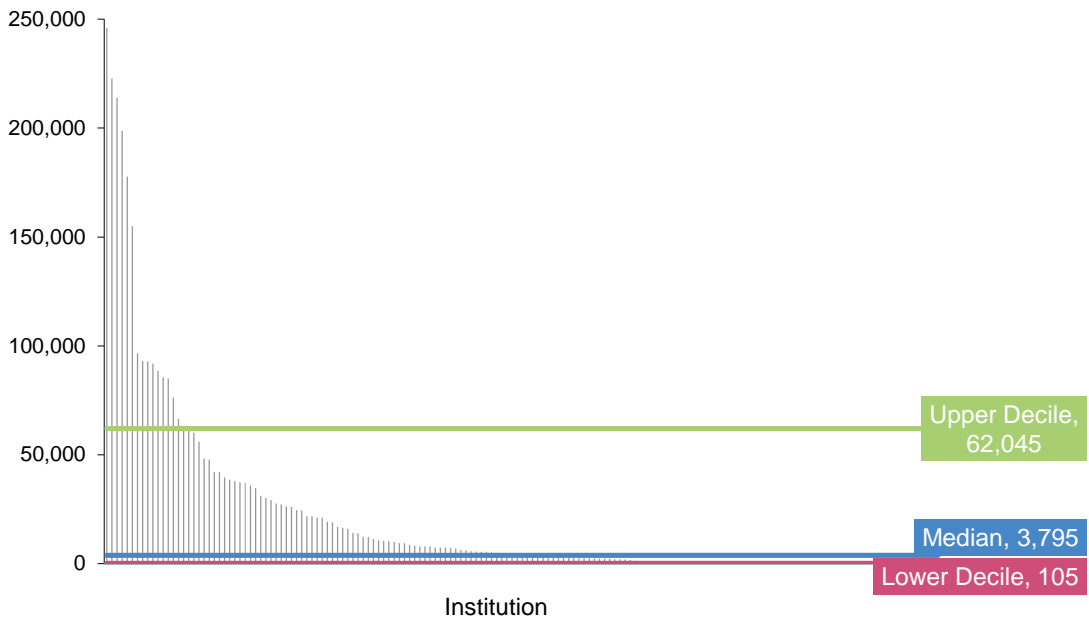
25. Percentage ratio of total funding body grants to total income



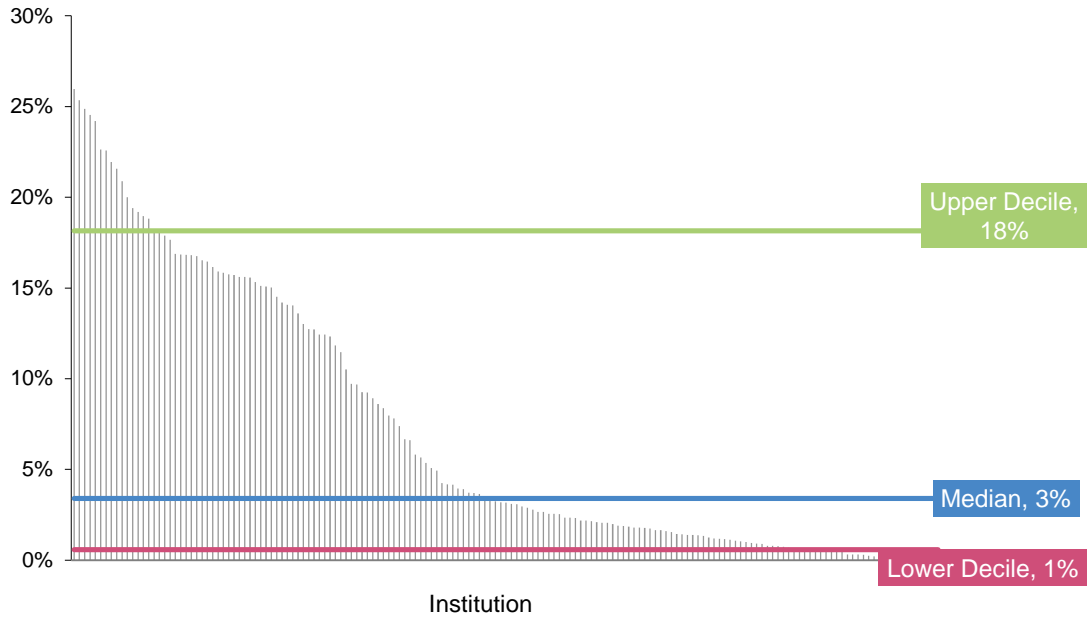
26. Percentage ratio of recurrent teaching grants from funding bodies for HE provision to total income



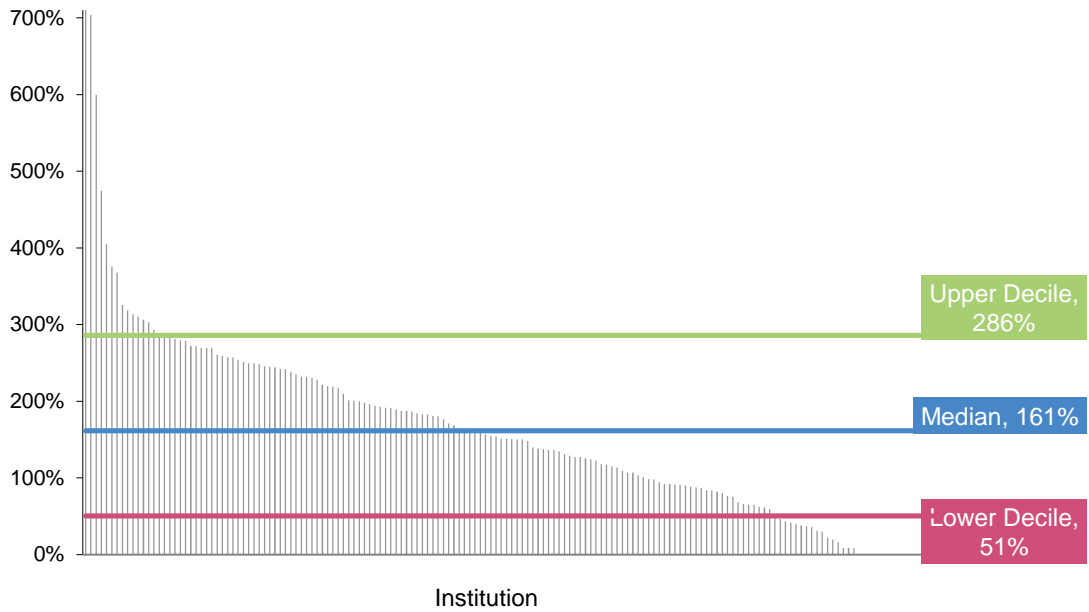
27. Funding of research through the dual support system (£000)



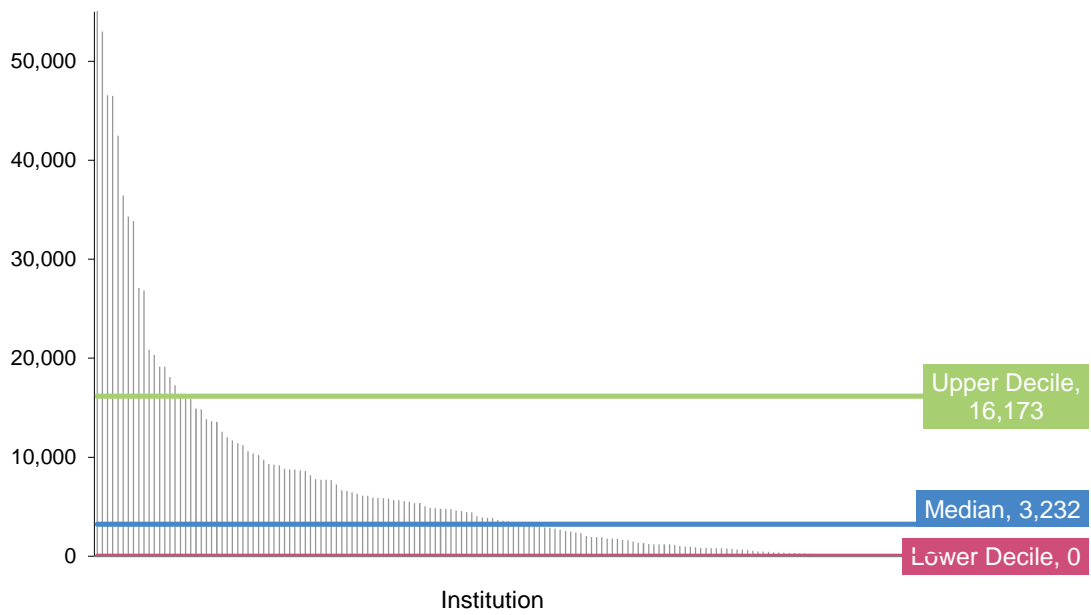
28. Funding of research through the dual support system as a percentage of total income



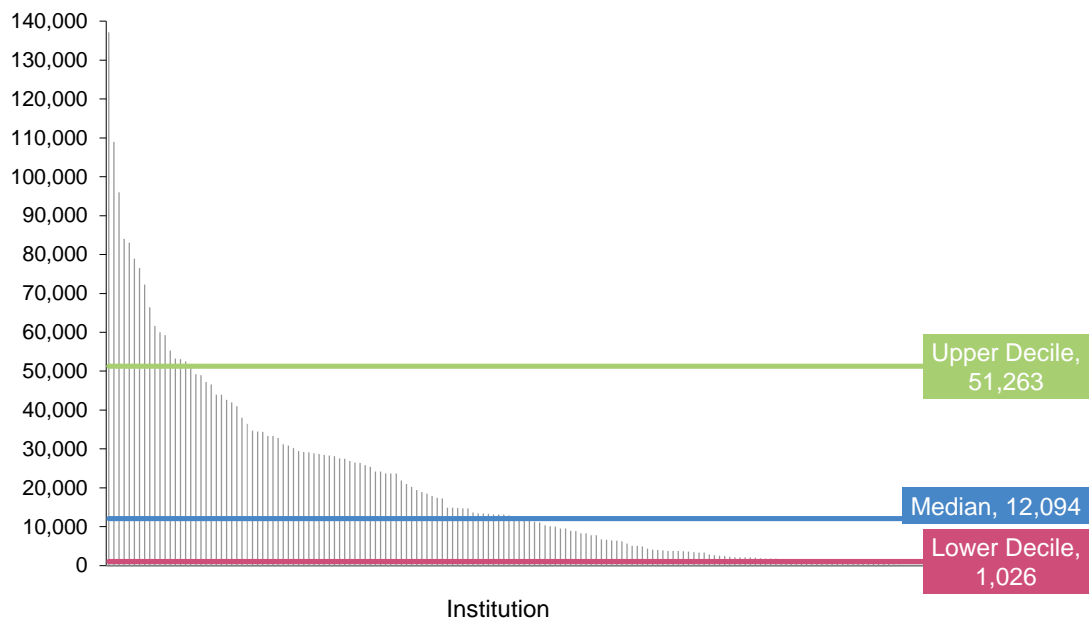
29. Research grants and contracts as a percentage of funding council research grant



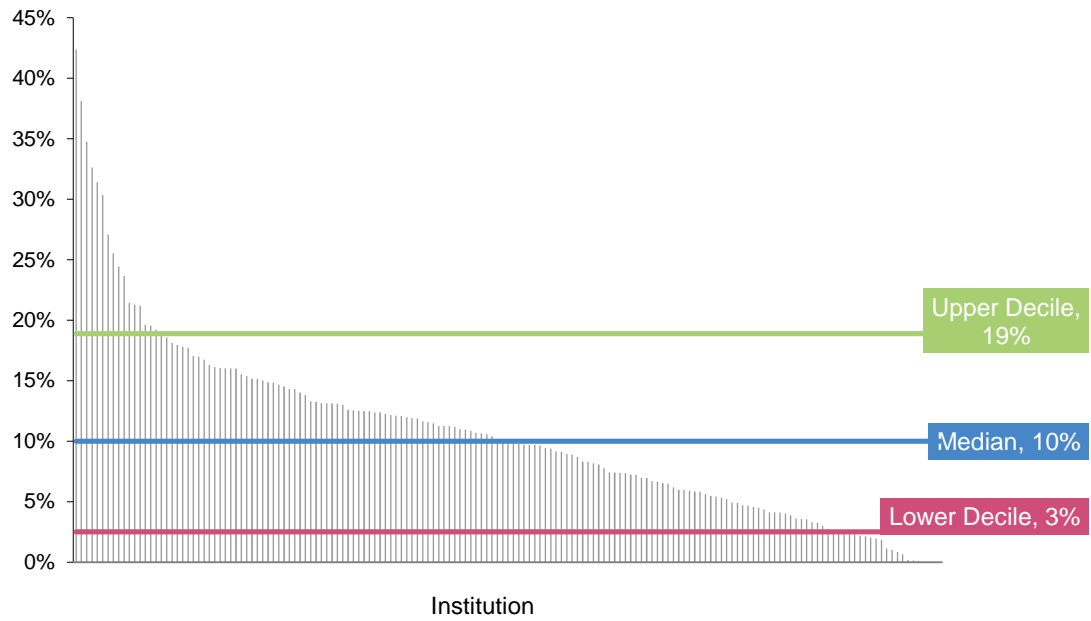

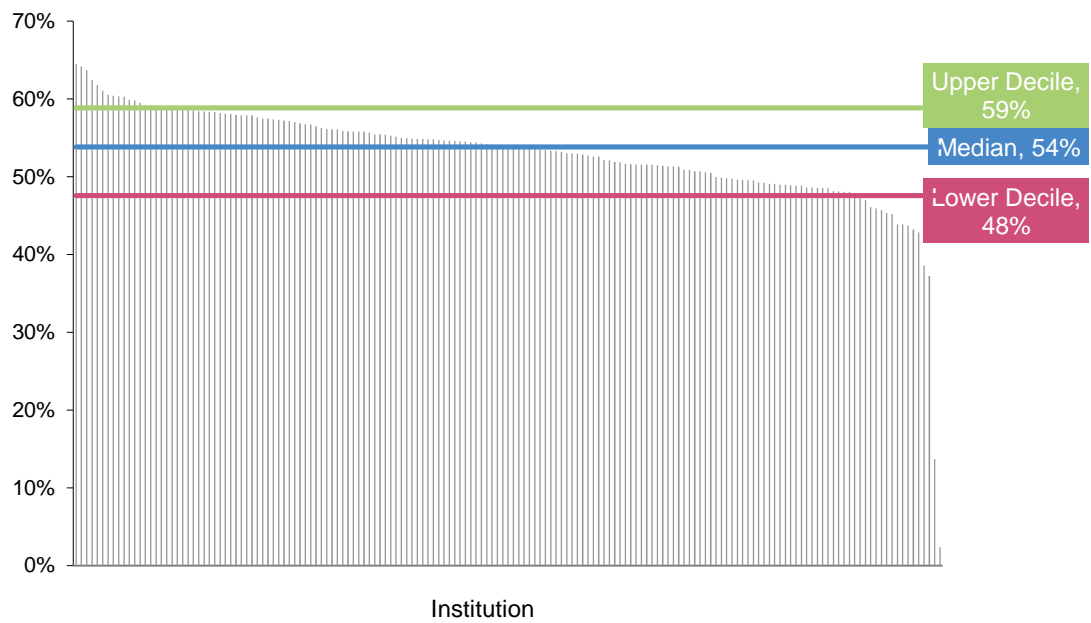

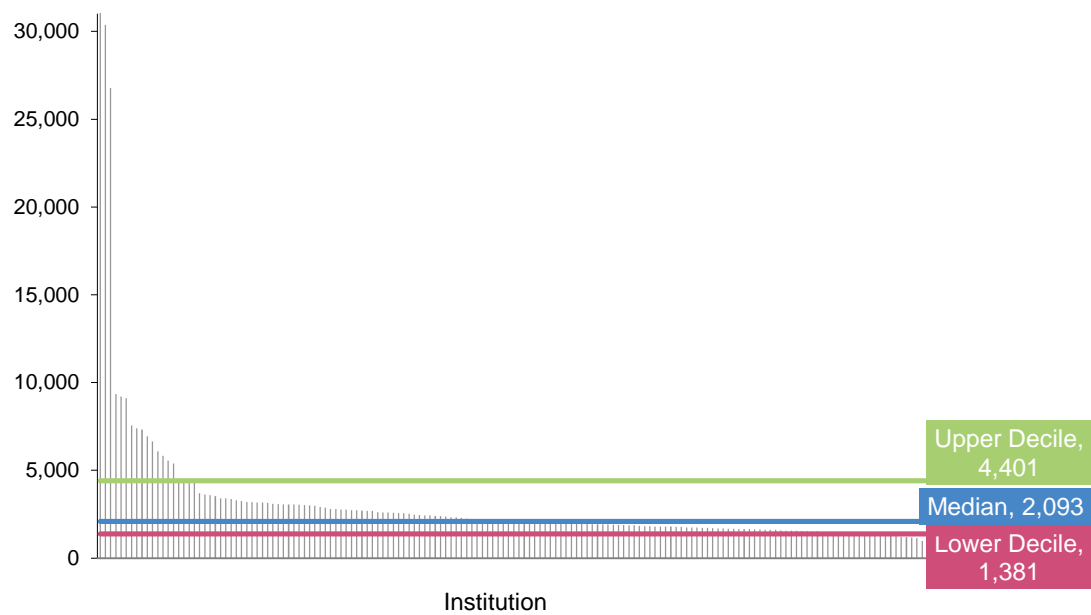
32. Income from non-EU student fees as a percentage of total income



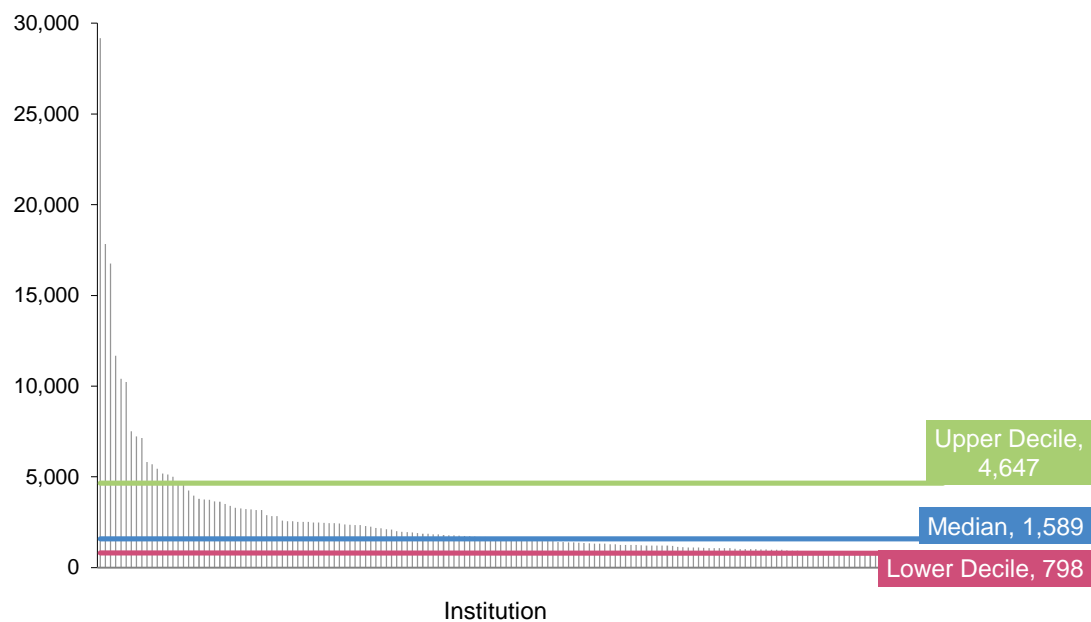
33. Ratio of staff payroll costs to total income



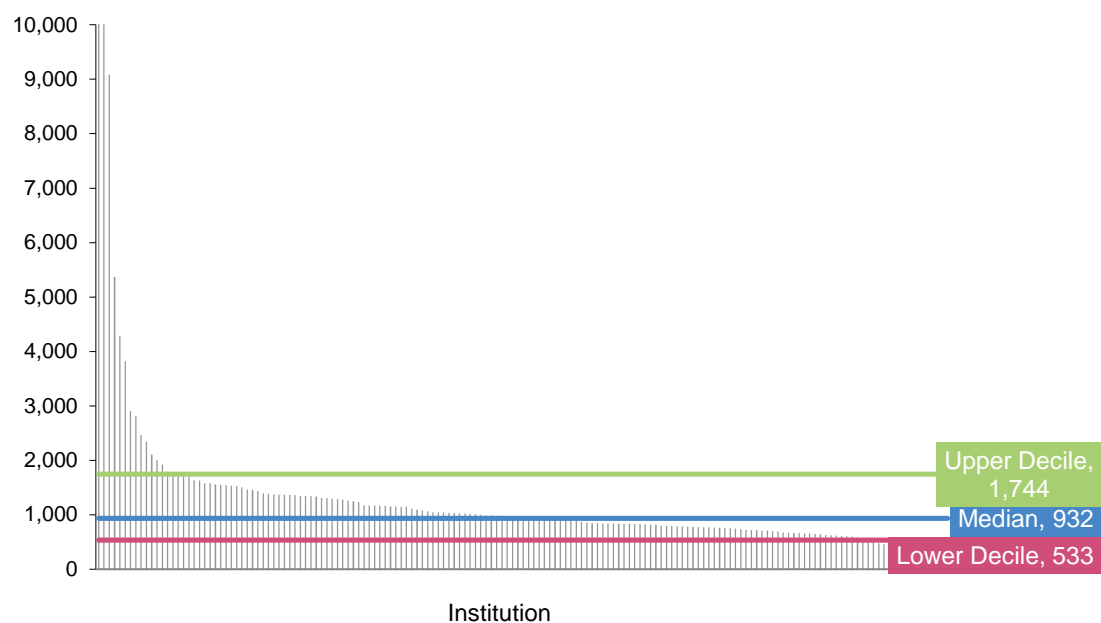
34. Administrative expenditure per full-time equivalent student (£)
