







## UK-Ukraine R&I twinning grants scheme selection criteria Annex B

The following rubric will be used to score each of the 3 areas:

- 1. Partnership and proposed activity
- 2. Capacity strengthening and additionality
- 3. Operational feasibility of project

Meaningful engagement with the Gender Equality Statement will also be assessed and shortlisted applications may be returned for further development of the statement if warranted. Projects must be compliant with the ODA requirements of this grant scheme, and this will be evaluated at the eligibility-check stage of the assessment process. Applications that are not ODA compliant as assessed through the ODA statement will not be awarded through this grant scheme.
